Main Ministry Objectives

- Serve as a collaborator, partner, encourager, and co-leader with PRCC's other youth
 minister. Develop a working relationship based on mutual trust and respect, understanding
 and appreciating each other's gifts and talents.
- Spend quality time with students so that you have the right to have a powerful conversation and share the truth of Jesus. Enter the world of the families of PRCC. Find areas that are important to them, and strive to bring fun, adventure, friendship, inclusiveness. In spending quality time with students, you earn the right to have powerful conversations and share the truth of Jesus.
- Attend extra-curricular activities, lunches, focusing on boys in the youth ministry.
- Work with the children's ministry to collaborate on occasional programs, events, and
 activities for these two groups. We operate with a NextGen model, aiming to provide
 seamless ministry for our kids from cradle to cap and gown. We can describe this exciting
 model more with our candidates.
- Promote upcoming events and document past events for social media posts.

- Participate in PRCC classes, events and programs as a sponsor with the goal of growing relationships and connections across various age groups throughout the church body.
- Organize and lead events for teen boys and their dads, including other PRCC men (dads of daughters, men of other generations) where it makes sense.
- Work to create intergenerational relationships within men and PRCC teen boys.
- Lead and execute all PRCC ministry events within the Child Safety Guidelines (to protect our students and our ministers).
- Offer support around the office when needed answering phones, doors, etc.

Measurability/Reporting

- This position will work alongside and parallel to the other youth minister, will report directly to the senior minister, and be under the leadership and guidance of the PRCC Elders.
- Be prepared to report/update weekly activities and events each Monday at staff meetings and at monthly elder meetings as requested.
- Set and maintain high performance standards. Pay close attention to detail, accuracy and completeness.
- Have direct Christian mentorship by an adult within & outside of PRCC Staff.

General Office Expectations

- Youth ministry requires some consistent office hours, but it also demands that you be at the students' activities as well. We will work with you to select some consistent times in the office, but we recognize some of your work hours will be after 5 pm. We would expect 40 hours of work each week.
- Stay aware of comp time you accrue and coordinate that with the appropriate staff.
- Respond to incoming communication (texts, emails, etc.) within one business day.
